

# GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Registration and waiver form must be returned to Area 10 Agency on Aging at

2. Anyone can play! Participants must be age 50 or older on or before August 28, 2015.
3. Age divisions are 50-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, & 90+. Participants must compete in their own age category.  
Gender and Age divisions will be used only in the following events:  
Ball Throws                      Park Events                      Hot Shot Basketball  
Horseshoes                      8 Ball Pool                      Bowling  
Shuffleboard                      Track Events
4. Persons may register for as many events as they wish, but must be sure to avoid signing up for events that overlap in times. **Participants must score at least one point to receive a medal.**
5. Participants must report to the event coordinator no later than 10 minutes prior to the event (**track events report immediately**) or risk being disqualified from that event.
6. Equipment used for the Senior Games competition will be supplied by the Senior Games organizers and/or participating facilities, except for golf, bowling, and softball. **Participants may not use own equipment in park events or horseshoes.**
7. Awards will be given to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each event by age and gender categories, where appropriate. In addition, there will be a female and male overall winner which will be determined by using a point system; 1st place receives 3 points, 2nd place receives 2 points, and 3rd place receives 1 point. Overall winners must be residents of Monroe or Owen Counties.
8. Sportsmanlike conduct is expected at all times. Failure to participate in a friendly manner, use of profanity, or intentional game delays will result in dismissal. This decision is left to the event coordinators and officials.
9. Area 10 Agency on Aging will provide bottled water at each event.
